Our main source of carbon emissions is driving. Our team's Carpooling rose to 11%, and 17% commute sustainably.

Sustainable Projects

There were zero fatalities and no lost time with injuries recorded. This year we have completed **20 projects**, over **1.1 million man hours worked**, and **transformed over 34,600 sqm of space**. Of these projects **30% were externally accredited**, this includes **3 LEED Gold Projects, 3 LEED Silver projects, 1 LEED certification, and 1 WELL Gold**. All projects also adhere to UAE construction standards.

18 Nationalities

Summertown has grown to **160 employees representing 18 nationalities**. In a male-dominated industry, **one-third of our office staff are women**. **Every employee has completed Human Rights and Anti-Corruption training**, with an average of 11.3 training hours per person.

We have had an **83% increase** in the volume of waste that is being sent to the **recycling**. We have also decreased the amount of waste sent to landfill to only 509.9 kg. The ratio of recycling to waste is 2.48:1 kg. We aim to increase this ratio by decreasing the amount of waste produced.
